Advocates USA is proud to present Arthur McClure Scholarships to a young man and a young woman who are using golf, academics and community service to make a difference in the world. Arthur McClure was a long time executive at Arco. He dedicated much of his life to helping young people be the very best they can be. Art passed away in 2009. Art, an avid golfer joined a group of African American men in starting Advocates USA, a six year-old non-profit organization that provides financial assistance to African American organizations across the country.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants for the Arthur McClure Scholarship must be-

- A participant in one of the programs supported by Advocates USA.
- High School Seniors who plan to enroll or students who are already enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school.
- Children of the members of the Advocate USA Board of Directors may not apply.
- Applicants must have at least a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must have demonstrated leadership skills in a school or community organization.

Awards

There will be a minimum of two scholarships presented each year. One scholarship will go to a female and one to a male.
